



Mailboxes

Mailboxes installed in the Town-owned layout are placed at the owner's risk. To avoid or minimize potential damage to mailboxes, we request that residents check the stability of their mailboxes, replace rotted post and or connectors and place the mailbox as far back from the paved streets as is allowable by the Post Office.

Snow thrown/pushed when clearing roadways will destroy or damage all but the strongest of mailboxes and posts. The Town is not responsible for this damage.

Mailboxes that are physically struck by plows will be evaluated for further action.

All mailbox concerns must be received within (5) five business days of storm otherwise no action will be taken.

Fences / Stone Walls

The Town will assess damage to fences and stone walls. If your fence or stone wall is on the Town layout, we are not responsible for this damage.

If your fence or stone wall is on your property, we will repair the damage ONLY if it was struck and damaged by a Town plow truck.

Basketball Nets

Basketball nets within the right of way will impede plowing capabilities during a storm. We request that all nets be removed from the right of way so no damage will be incurred, and the roads are accessible for emergency vehicles, school buses and plow equipment. The Town of Chelmsford is not responsible for any damage to nets hit by a plow. However, if there is damage done to a town vehicle for failure to remove the basketball net the homeowner will be held responsible for any damage to the town vehicle.
